The Department of Forestry, Fisheries and the Environment (DFFE) on 5 November 2020 published under the National Environmental Management Waste Act # 59 of 2008, an EPR regulatory notice for identified waste streams of paper and packaging, electrical & electronic equipment (EEE) and lighting which ultimately came into effect 5 May 2021 under Section 18 of the Act.

- Set up for failure and in disarray.

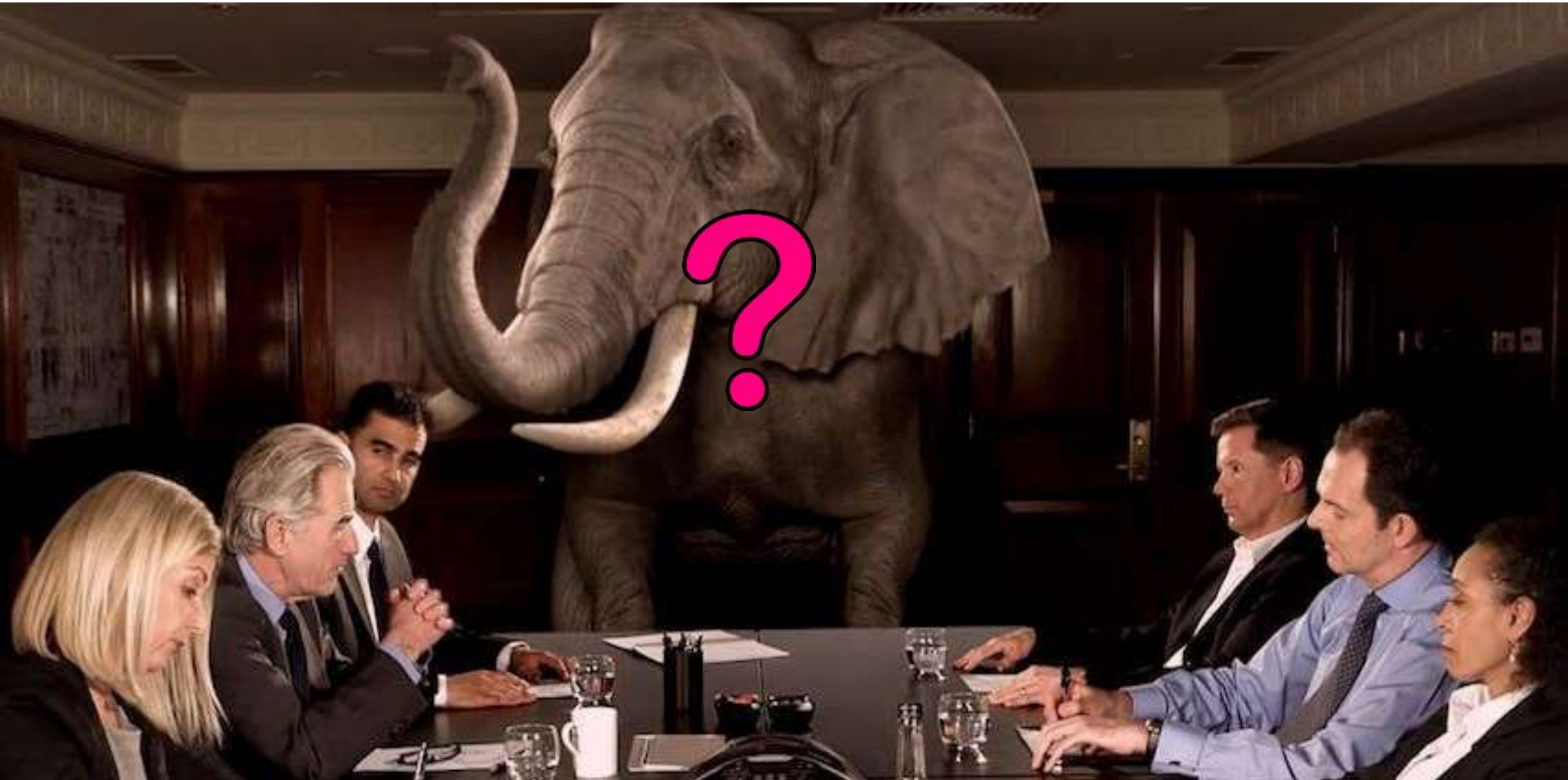


- Many more questions than answers.
